## Please read the following policies very carefully with your child:

Our goal is to provide the highest quality instruction possible in order to prepare our students for college. To achieve this goal it is imperative that students take their coursework very seriously. You will find that our instructors are very supportive and will make every effort to help your child achieve his or her educational goals.

Absences and Tardies: Regular attendance is very important as these classes are very rigorous. A parent must call in to report an absence. If your child is sick the day of a scheduled class session, a parent must call and leave a message by 9:00 a.m Student phone calls will not be accepted. Students must arrive to class on time. Excessive tardies and absences may result in expulsion from the program.

Homework and Grades: Completion of homework is extremely important. Reading and note-taking is expected to be done outside of class. If a student fails to come prepared to class, parents will be notified. If a student's grade falls below 75%, the parent will be notified and plans will be set in place to provide extra assistance. Our goal at High Bluff Academy is mastery of the subject as demonstrated by a grade of 75% or higher on all exams and assignments. All efforts will be made to support students to meet this level, however, no grades are guaranteed. Students who fail to make a sincere effort to attend all classes, arrive on time, participate in class and complete homework may be asked to leave the program. Disruptive or rude behavior will not be tolerated. Parents will be notified immediately if any problems arise and a good faith effort will be made to work with both the parents and child to remedy the situation. If the student fails to improve, he or she may be asked to leave the program.
